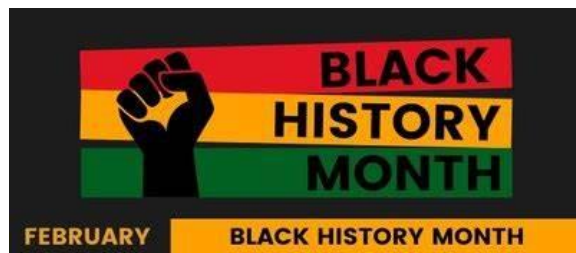
CELEBRATE! Culture & Diversity
